Call to order and chalice lighting

Report of Policy Board Representative: Rosemary Lawton, Policy Board VP

Slate for next year's Council and Policy Board was attached to the agenda.

Board is preparing for the Annual Meeting and looking at preparing for returning to the church building.

Committees were put together for the Fathman and Ross awards.

The wording for the Staff Recognition Fund was finalized.

Report of Minister: Rev. Kim Mason

Mission statement - wording was finalized at the last board meeting. The statement is in the by-laws and it will be voted on at the Annual Meeting.

Rev. Mason has been working with a group on hybrid ministry for the coming church year. The group won a contest for UU churches to get a professional assessment for live streaming of services. The estimated cost for the equipment is \$10,000 - \$12,000.

Canvass is nearly complete and while we did not meet our goal, it was very successful.

Reports of Cluster Chairs:

- Steve Smidowicz Stewardship Cluster
 - o Canvass update
 - 71 pledge units increased their pledge 50 of which increased by 10%. 90% of Friends pledged. As of now we are at \$381,000.00 which is an increase over last year.
 - o Budget discussion, including drawing from endowment to cover expenses of streaming worship services.

Discussion on how to fund plumbing repair, refinishing the Chapel floor, new tables and chairs in Fellowship Hall and the live streaming equipment. Proposed that the funds for the live streaming come from the additional Endowment Funds that were approved at the Annual Meeting last year. The question is if since we are running a surplus is it okay to take the funds out of the Endowment.

Proposed to use Endowment funds for live streaming equipment, use Special Gifts and Memorial for the plumbing expense and Fellowship Hall furniture and Capital Maintenance funds for the Chapel Floor. Clint Cruse moved to approve the expenditures as described and seconded by Cathy Rauch. Passed unanimously.

• Clint Cruse – Facilities Cluster

Maintenance: plumbing solution

The preschool room floor has been opened and looking for an additional plumbing bid to replace the pipe.

The Kingshighway fence was repaired.

Developing ideas for the Memorial Garden for an ornamental piece to go into the space where the Ash Tree was. Will engage the congregation more in developing ideas.
