General discussion about the funding of a Clark Lecture that Toward Justice is recommending. Financially it would require using available funds from 2 years. People were generally favorable about the suggested speaker - concerns that there is not a Clark Lecture Committee in place. Council members will further review the speaker and the financing will be explored and a decision made by March 8th.

  - Maintenance: plumbing problem Another option for the preschool leak is being explored.
- Sue Herzberg Programming Cluster
  - RE Coming of Age class started meeting again. A 9:00 am Minecraft class has been started. The 11:30 offering is all ages. A search team for a permanent RE director is being formed.
  - Worship Cmte: Working on their budget and want to increase budget for paid speakers, especially people of color. Also looking at how to move forward with hybrid ministry in the fall.
  - Play space ground breaking event ERDE will be participating in this event with the RE
    Committee. This will happen on March 14th (small in-person group and virtual).
- Erin Milligan Growth & Engagement Cluster
  - Care and Concern is now headed by Karen Siegrist, Judi Crouch and Larry Dusenbery.
    They are collecting information from the existing team to see who is actually interested in still being active.

- Knitting Ministry changed their name to Needlework Ministry.
- The Women's Alliance is having an internal auction with one another to raise money for their scholarship fund. Virtual meetings are increasing their attendance.
- Membership Committee will meet on March 1st. Will plan spring calls. They attend
  Newcomer chats and a Membership class is planned for the spring. Erin Milligan met
  with the Committee on Ministry who is looking at the membership process.
